


In-Room Setup

1. Setup Lectern

» Login to PC. e.g. jblogs@dundee.ac.uk

camera for best capture




2. Open presentation content

» Open your PowerPoint presentation or visual aid to share. (Don't start the presentation, just open it)

3. Open YuJa application

» Launch YuJa by pressing the Windows key on the keyboard (or type directly in the search bar), type "Yuja" and click 'YuJa Software Capture'



» If prompted - Login to the capture application, select 'University of Dundee' from the drop down and login using Single Sign-On (SSO) and click 'Sign In'

4. YuJa application

- » Click 'Title'. Enter a meaningful name (can be changed later) "BS32001 Genome comparison"
- » Click the share icon beside the title, select the publish location i.e. your module in My Dundee.
- » You can type your module code to shorten the list, select the module (most recent at the bottom) and click 'SELECT'



5. Check the recording profile 6. Start Recording

- » Each room has a pre-defined profile (same as room name) so you should be able to just leave everything as is.
- » You can double check sources

7. Launch presentation

- » When the countdown timer starts start your presentation
- » Begin presenting

8. Managing your recording

- » Use the YuJa 'mini-bar' to pause the capture at any point recording
- » Can also use Hotkeys
- » Start Recording: CTRL + SHIFT + S
- » Pause Recording: CTRL + SHIFT + P
- » Finish Recording: CTRL + SHIFT + F

9. Stop & Publish/Save

- » Click on 'stop' on the mini-bar or 'Ctrl+Shift+F' to stop the recording.
- » Click on 'Post Now' to publish recording to your module
- » Or click on 'Save' to save your capture recording to My Media
